

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL  
OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON,

AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO  
PURCHASE FOUR SPEED MONITOR ADVISORY SIGNS**

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has indicated a need for speed monitors for the Borough due to the number of complaints of speeding motorists; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has indicated that the monitors will alert motorists of their speed and encourage maintaining the speed limit, for the safety of both the driver and residential community.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the Police Chief is authorized to purchase four (4) Speed Monitor Advisory Signs, at the cost of approximately \$3,500.00 per sign.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
