

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY,
AUTHORIZING THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
TO COMPLETE A ROAD STUDY**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mount Arlington is desirous of studying the traffic patterns and driver/pedestrian safety at the intersection of Howard Boulevard and Interstate Route 80 West, Exit 30 Ramp; and

WHEREAS, should the NJDOT Road Study prove to present driver and pedestrian hazards at this intersection, the Borough of Mount Arlington would implement plans to install a traffic light at said intersection.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the New Jersey Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to perform the necessary due diligence needed to provide a Road Study, at no cost to the Borough.
