**RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE
DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT OF
OFF-DUTY MUNICIPAL OFFICERS**

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonable estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides for receipt of outside employment of off-duty municipal officers by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from the outside employment of off-duty municipal officers are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council, Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Governing Body does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to pay expenditures of outside employment of off-duty municipal officers.
2. The Clerk of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, is hereby directed to forward two certified copies of this Resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
