

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY,
IN MEMORY OF GERARD MICHAEL CURTIN**

Whereas, the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington have learned of the untimely death of longtime resident **Gerard Michael Curtin**, a Navy veteran, serving our country during the Korean War; and

Whereas, **Gerard Michael Curtin**, was a resident of Mount Arlington for 40 years, served on the Borough Council, and longtime Master Poll Worker with the Morris County Board of Elections; and,

Whereas, **Gerard Michael Curtin** was a Democrat and the year he ran for Council Member, the election polls extended their hours, closing at 10:00 p.m., due to the large amount of people who came out to vote for him; and,

Whereas, while serving as Council Member, **Gerard Michael Curtin** often assisted the Department of Public Works employees in the winter, shoveling snow and driving the plow trucks; and,

Whereas, **Gerard Michael Curtin**, was a past President and longtime active member of the Lake Rogerene Civic Association, and successfully received a grant to pave the dirt roads in and around Lake Rogerene; and

Whereas, **Gerard Michael Curtin**, was the founder of the Green Mountain Boys, consisting of the Lake Rogerene Fire Department members, who sponsored an annual fundraiser with the children of the Lake area.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, assembled in public session this 2nd day of April, 2013, that all the flags in the Borough of Mount Arlington shall be flown at half-staff on Wednesday, April 10, 2013 in honor of **Gerard Michael Curtin** and in recognition of his years of service to the Borough and community; and,

Be It Further Resolved that a certified copy of this Resolution be presented to the family of **Gerard Michael Curtin** as an expression of the condolences of the Borough of Mount Arlington.
