WHEREAS, the Director may also approve the insertion of an item of appropriation for equal amount,



This office is pleased to inform you that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has awarded Mount Arlington Borough a Hazard Mitigation grant for a generator project. The period of performance is September 17, 2015 through September 17, 2018, with an expenditure deadline of September 17, 2017. The total project cost is \$75,280.00 with a Federal share of \$55,905.00, and a non-Federal share of \$19,375.00

A "Grantee/Sub-grantee Agreement" for this project is in the process of being developed for your endorsement and is forthcoming. Project work should not begin until the agreement is signed by both the grantee and sub-grantee.
