RESOLUTION #2016 - 175

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING SALARY STEP INCREASES AND RETRO-ACTIVE PAYMENT TO OFFICER JOSEPH PARICHUK, OFFICER MATTHEW FORTUNATO AND OFFICER RYAN SHERBURNE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOP AGREEMENT THAT EXPIRED DECEMBER 31, 2015

WHEREAS, the Collective Bargaining Agreement (“Agreement”) between the Borough of Mount Arlington and the FOP Lodge 78 expired on December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the parties are currently negotiating and finalizing the terms of a new Agreement and anticipate executing the Agreement for the term of January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement that expired on December 31, 2015 delineates an incremental step increase from step 3 to step 4 from the amount of \$55,533.00 to \$63,806.00 for Officer Joseph Parichuk; and


WHEREAS, the Agreement that expired on December 31, 2015 delineates an incremental step increase from step 4 to step 5 from the amount of \$63,806.00 to \$72,079.00 for Officer Matthew Fortunato and Officer Ryan Sherburne; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington desire to provide the step increases to the Officers; and accordingly at the October 4, 2016 Borough Council meeting approved the step increases and instructed that the salaries be paid accordingly and retroactive to January 1, 2016.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington approved the salary step increases retroactive to January 1, 2016 for Officer Joseph Parichuk, Officer Matthew Fortunato and Officer Ryan Sherburne.

This resolution shall be effective immediately.
