RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY REDUCING THE AMOUNT OF ITS PETTY CASH FUND TO \$300

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-21 authorizes the establishment of a Petty Cash Fund in any county or municipality by application and resolution, and

BE OT FURTHER RESOLVED that the custodian for this fund be the Chief Financial Officer who is bonded in the amount of \$1,000.00; such custodian shall maintain records for this fund in a manner conducive to property accounting and auditing procedures.
