RESOLUTION REQUIRING ALL PUBLIC EMPLOYEES TO CONTRIBUTE 1.5% OF THEIR BASE SALARY TOWARDS HEALTH BENEFITS AS REQUIRED BY CH. 2. P.L. 2010

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted on June 17, 1998, the Borough elected to participate in the State Health Benefits Program, Chapter 88, P.L. 1974; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ch. 2, P.L. 2010, effective May 21, 2010, the State of New Jersey has required all public employees to contribute 1.5% of their base salary towards health benefits and that in the case of employees covered by a collective bargaining agreement, that upon the expiration of the contractual term, shall also contribute 1.5% of their base salary towards health benefits; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of this Resolution do not apply to members of F.O.P. Lodge No. 78 ("Union"), until the expiration of their current contract, at which time they shall also contribute 1.5% of their base salary towards health benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mt. Arlington as follows:

- 1. Effective May 21, 2010, all public employees to contribute 1.5% of their base salary towards health benefits and
- 2. With regard to members of F.O.P. Lodge No. 78 ("Union"), upon the expiration of their current contract, they shall also contribute 1.5% of their base salary towards health benefits
- 3. The Business Administrator, Finance Department and all other applicable employees of the Borough are authorized and directed to take any and all action necessary to implement the terms and intent of this Resolution; and
- 4. The terms of any Resolution which conflict with any provision of this Resolution are hereby amended to be in accordance with the terms and intent of this Resolution.
