

**Resolution Of The *Borough of Mount Arlington*
Making Application To The Division of Local Government Services
For Transitional Aid Program**

WHEREAS, the *Mayor and Council* of the Borough of Mount Arlington in the *County of Morris* desires to make application to the Division of Local Government Services to make request for additional state aid to address a significant property tax increase and due to fiscal conditions outside of the Borough's control pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27D-118.35 et seq. and,

WHEREAS, the *Mayor and Council* believes that:

- (a) it is in the public interest to accomplish such purpose; and,
- (b) the application for transitional aid will be for betterment of the inhabitants of the *Borough of Mount Arlington*; and,
- (c) the proposal is an efficient and feasible means of providing services for the needs of the inhabitants of the *Borough of Mount Arlington* and will assist the borough in not creating an undue financial burden to be placed upon the *Borough of Mount Arlington*;

The application to the Division of Local Government Services is hereby approved, and the Chief Financial Officer, along with other representatives of the *Borough of Mount Arlington* are hereby authorized to prepare such application and to represent the *Borough of Mount Arlington* in matters pertaining thereto.


