NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Borough strongly endorses the continuing efforts and the proposed budget of the Lake Hopatcong Commission.
- 2. The Borough strongly urges the State to provide all necessary funding to allow the Lake Hopatcong Commission to continue its excellent work in preserving and improving Lake Hopatcong.
- 3. The Borough Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to New Jersey Governor Chris Christie, Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Protection Mark Mauriello, the Morris and Sussex Legislative Delegation, Freeholder Board of Morris and Sussex Counties, and all municipal members of the Lake Hopatcong Commission.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
