- Kadel Drive (One Way), west to east from Robert Terrace to Howard Boulevard, during the hours of 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- Altenbrand Avenue from North Glen to Howard Boulevard, during the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that temporary road closure and parking restrictions as specified above for the Memorial Day Parade take effect on May 30, 2011, with a rain date of June 4, 2011.
