

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, authorizing Nisivoccia, LLP, to provide a Cost Study Analysis of a Police Contracted Service

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Mount Arlington is considering a Police Contracted Service between the Borough of Mount Arlington and Roxbury Township; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Mount Arlington requires further analysis and evaluation of the scope and cost of this type of Contracted Service; and,


WHEREAS, the Certified Public Accountant and Advisory firm of Nisivoccia, LLP has agreed to provide such a study at a cost not to exceed \$10,000.;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey are requesting an Analysis from Nisivoccia, LLP to include, but not limited to, the following information:

Cost of the current Mount Arlington Police Department compared to proposal from Roxbury Township and any ongoing proposals; review and advise on any issues raised pertaining to proposals (i.e. allocation of costs, other allocation methods and comparisons, costs that should be included or if any, excluded); Health Benefits (Cobra costs); overtime projections for both Police Departments, Court considerations (contract and revenue); and projection of costs to maintain existing Borough Police Department as is. All information should be projected for a minimum of five (5) years.
