PERMIT) FOR THE HOWARD BOULEVARD PEDESTRIAN WALKWAYS TO THE  
MOUNT ARLINGTON TRAIN STATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Mount Arlington is in need of walkways along Howard Boulevard to the Mount Arlington Train Station; and


**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that due to safety issues, this project needs immediate attention; and

**WHEREAS**, the entire cost of the project is paid for by previously awarded grant, except those expenses listed on the attached Suburban Engineers Consulting letter dated September 27, 2011, which expenses have been approved by Council.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that Suburban Consulting Engineering is allowed to proceed with the project plans (in accordance with the NJDOT Highway Access Permit) for the Howard Boulevard Pedestrian Walkways to the Mount Arlington Train Station project.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

As discussed, a purchase order is required for services associated with the final design, permitting, construction administration and inspection tasks remaining for the Howard Boulevard Pedestrian Walkways to the Mount Arlington Train Station project. The construction documents, which are 75% complete, were performed over the past several years as a joint effort between our office and New Jersey Transit. This project required the completion of the final design and specifications for bidding along with the preparation and execution of a NJDOT Highway Access Permit for work under Route 80.

The following is our estimate of services required for completion of the remaining tasks:

- Final Design Plans and Specifications \$ 4,500.00
- NJDOT Permitting \$ 1,250.00
- Bid Phase \$ 750.00
- Construction Administration and Inspection \$12,500.00
- Total Cost Estimate** \$19,000.00
