A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CONSENTING TO THE PROPOSED WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT (WQM) PLAN AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) requires that proposed wastewater treatment and conveyance facilities and wastewater treatment service areas, as well as related subjects, be in conformance with an approved WOM plan; and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP has established the WQM plan amendment procedure as the method of incorporating changes to the delineation of future wastewater service areas into a WQM plan; and

WHEREAS, a proposed WQM plan amendment noticed in the New Jersey Register on June 18, 2012 for the Upper Delaware, Upper Raritan and Northeast WQM plan has been prepared by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the County of Morris.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mount Arlington recognizes the need for a future Water Quality Management Plan Map amendment to facilitate the necessity to provide sanitary sewer service to the residents in the vicinity of Lake Rogerene.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 7th day of August, 2012, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington that:

- 1. The Mayor and Borough Council hereby consent to the Proposed Water Quality Management Plan for the purpose of its incorporation into the applicable WQM plan(s).
- 2. This consent shall be submitted to the NJDEP in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4.
- 3. It is understood that the NJDEP and the County of Morris will support the Borough of Mount Arlington in establishing a viable sanitary sewer service area for the residents in the vicinity of Lake Rogerene.
