RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING WAIVER OF CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FEES FOR CONSTRUCTION WORK MADE NECESSARY BY HURRICANE DAMAGE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, along with other New Jersey communities, suffered extreme damage to properties as a result of Hurricane Sandy, which struck New Jersey on October 29, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council is aware of the devastation and destruction resident and property owners have experienced, and continue to experience due to property damage; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Borough Council to assist property owners in their endeavor to repair and rebuild their properties; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.19(b)5, the State of New Jersey has provided municipalities the option of waiving permit fees for work made necessary by damages of Hurricane Sandy, which would also waive State Permit Surcharge Fees.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, that municipal construction permit fees for construction work made necessary by Hurricane Sandy be and are hereby waived for construction permit applications received by the Mount Arlington Borough Construction Offices on or before December 31, 2014; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the New Jersey Division of Codes and Standards, the Borough Construction Official and Chief Financial Officer.
