**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ESTABLISHING SWIMMING LESSON FEES
FOR THE YEAR 2012**

WHEREAS, the Borough has authorized the provision of swimming lessons under Ordinance 16-03; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 16-03 provides that fees for such swimming lessons shall be established annually by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the fee for a series of lessons (three weeks, two days per week) will be \$100 per student, payable to the Borough, and no refunds will be made once the classes have begun; and

WHEREAS, Natalie Senatore is a qualified Lifeguard and will organize and supervise the scheduling of such swimming lessons at the municipal beach:

WHEREAS, the following are qualified swimming lesson instructors: Natalie Senatore, John Lloyd, Tyler Povanda, Ryan Rutkoski, Shaina Kassaleh and Kyle Kassaleh; and

WHEREAS, the instructional Lifeguard will be compensated \$100 per series of lessons.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington that the annual fee for swimming lessons for the year 2012 is adopted as set forth above.
