

September 13, 2011

BOARD OF HEALTH REGULAR MEETING

The regular meeting of the Board of Health was called to order by President Tuorinsky at 7:08 pm. Adequate notice of this meeting has been submitted to the Roxbury Register and Daily Record and notice is posted on the bulletin board in the main lobby of Borough Hall.

The members saluted the flag.

ROLL CALL: Present: Tuorinsky, Westerfield, Puskas, Anderson, Morance. Absent: O'Reilly-Stanzilis, Albanese, Councilman Cangiano. Health Officer Frank Wilpert present.

Member Morance made a motion to approve the minutes of July 26, 2011, seconded by Member Puskas.

Review of Health Officer's and Nurses Reports.

F. Wilpert reminded the Board of the last meeting in that Councilman Cangiano was to get back to F. Wilpert regarding a leaking septic. F. Wilpert did not hear back from Councilman Cangiano, therefore he was unable to follow up.

F. Wilpert went over the Health Officer's report and nurse's report.

F. Wilpert explained that there was one beach sample that did not pass; the sample taken the next day did pass. Food inspections were made after the hurricane and all establishments inspected were found to be satisfactory.

F. Wilpert reviewed all complaints listed in the Health officer's report.

14 Elizabeth Way: Not a health issue at this time. President Tuorinsky asked if there had been other incidents at this location, Admin. Simari replied there had not been an issue at this location in several years.

28 Sunset Terr. Unit 9: Overflowing dumpster/rodents. As of September 13, 2011, dumpster has been completely cleaned up.

536 Curtis Rd.: Debris in yard/rodents. As of September 13, 2011, all has been cleaned up.

President Tuorinsky asked if the appearance of rodents could be due to the recent hurricane. F. Wilpert replied that could be the issue. Brief discussion regarding bedbugs.
