

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL
OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, IN THE COUNTY
OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL HEALTH
SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE FOR
CERTAIN HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE YEARS 2014 THROUGH 2016**

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Borough of Mount Arlington wishes to enter into a contract for certain health services to be provided by the Township of Mount Olive; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-3 provides that an autonomous board established within a single local unit may become a party to such a contract with the consent of the governing body of the local unit, which consent shall be expressed by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington wishes to consent to the execution of an Agreement between the Mount Arlington Board of Health and the Township of Mount Olive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:


1. The Borough Council hereby consents to the execution of an interlocal health services Agreement between the Board of Health of the Borough of Mount Arlington and the Township of Mount Olive for the years 2014 through 2016. The total costs associated with said Agreement are:

2014	\$36,246
2015	\$36,970
2016	\$37,710

2. The Board of Health has authorized execution of said Agreement.
3. The Borough Clerk and the Secretary of the Board of Health are directed to retain on file in their respective offices in the Municipal Building of the Borough copies of said Agreement for inspection by the public in accordance with law.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
