AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REMOVING BOROUGH CODE CHAPTER 200 NUISANCES, PUBLIC HEALTH IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for the Borough of Mount Arlington reviewed the recommendations of the Board of Health requesting that Chapter 200 Nuisances, Public Health be deleted from the Borough Code because it is antiquated; and desires that same be removed in its entirety.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, and the State of New Jersey, that the Borough Code Chapter 200 Nuisances, Public Health, and any reference or mention to it throughout the code, is hereby removed and deleted its entirety.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3. If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase, or sentence is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed separable.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final publication as provided by law.
