

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL
OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF
MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY PARKING
RESTRICTIONS AND ROAD CLOSURES DURING THE
ROTARY CLUB OF LAKE HOPATCONG 5K RUN/WALK**

WHEREAS, The Rotary Club of Lake Hopatcong will be hosting a 5K Run/Walk on Saturday, June 9, 2018 in the Borough of Mount Arlington; and

WHEREAS, the 5K events will begin at 8:00 a.m. and the road closures will vary from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.; and,

WHEREAS, the 5K route and closure times will be as follows and the Rotary Club of Lake Hopatcong requests road closure and parking restrictions for the roads specified:


Route/Road Closures	Location of closure	Time of closure
N. Glen Ave	Closed entire length	8am until noon
Windemere Ave	Closed from N. Glen Ave to Bertrand Island Road**	9:00am to 11:00am
Bertrand Island Road	Closed entire length	See below*
Oak Street	Closed entire length	See below*
N. Bertrand Rd	Closed entire length	See below*
W. Bertrand Rd	Closed entire length	See below*
S. Bertrand Rd	Closed entire length	See below*

*The roads on Bertrand Island will be closed at 9:20 a.m. As the participants progress through the course the roads will be opened when they are no longer affected by the event. The estimated time of Bertrand Island roads being passable is between 10:00-10:30 a.m.

**There will be a detour route in effect to bypass the Windemere Ave closure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that temporary road closures and parking restrictions as specified above for the Rotary Club of Lake Hopatcong 5K Run/Walk take effect on June 9, 2018.
