### Town Ordinances for the Winter Months

**169-14** From December 1st to March 31st, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM on any day (except Sundays and public holidays) upon any streets or parts of streets within the Borough.

**169-9** Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the streets, no vehicle shall be parked on the streets or parts of streets within the Borough.

## SNOW REMOVAL



Mount Arlington Public Works Department is responsible for the removal of snow on Borough roads in Mount Arlington. It is unlawful to throw snow back onto a road that has been plowed. Also please observe the no parking on any street when roads are covered rules. Please note that vehicles parked on the street may be towed and/or ticketed by the Mt. Arlington Police Department.

The owner, occupant or person in charge of each and every dwelling house, store or other building and/or vacant lot(s) in the Borough of Mount Arlington shall, within 24 hours after every fall of snow or hail or the formation of ice upon the sidewalks in front and/or abutting upon such house, store or other building and/or vacant lot(s) remove or cause the same to be removed from the sidewalks adjacent to such dwelling house, store, building and/or vacant lot(s).



## Emergency situations:

When wind, snow or lightning storms, or other emergency situations arise outside normal business hours requiring immediate removal of a tree, call 973-398-2100, and the police dispatcher will contact appropriate municipal authorities.

The Mount Arlington Dial-a-Ride provides transportation to our senior and disabled residents. The Dial-A-Ride program operates Monday through Friday between 8:30 am and 3:30 pm. When Borough Hall is closed the van does not run, i.e. inclement weather, holidays.

Please make all transport reservations at least 24 hours in advance. To allow pick-up and drop-off, medical appointments should be made no earlier than 9:30 a.m. and no later than 2:00 p.m. Pick-up for shopping days will begin at 8:30 a.m. and drop-off at 9:00 a.m. Return pick-up will be at 10-10:30 a.m. Information, schedule and forms to enroll are available online <http://mountarlingtonnj.org/dial-a-ride>.
