AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF WHARTON FOR PROVIDING STREET

SWEEPING OF VARIOUS ROADS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wharton has received a request from the Borough of Mount

Arlington for providing street sweeping of various roads within the Borough of Mount

Arlington; and

WHEREAS, the length of this Agreement shall be effective on the date of execution

through December 31, 2013.

Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, New Jersey, that the aforesaid Agreement with

the terms set forth in the attached Agreement be accepted and that the Mayor and Borough Clerk

are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement.

AN INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF WHARTON AND THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON FOR THE PURPOSE OF STREET SWEEPING OF VARIOUS ROADS.

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 1st day of April, 2012 between the MOUNT ARLINGTON BOROUGH hereinafter referred to as the MTA BOROUGH and the BOROUGH OF WHARTON, hereinafter referred to as the "BOROUGH".

WHEREAS, pursuant to Interlocal Services Act, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq., local units may join together to provide authorized services for each other; and

WHEREAS, the BOROUGH and the MTA BOROUGH desire to join together in an agreement whereby the BOROUGH will perform on behalf of the MTA BOROUGH the sweeping of various roads within the MTA BOROUGH

WHEREAS, this agreement must be authorized by a Resolution adopted by the Mayor and Borough Council of the MTA BOROUGH, and a Resolution adopted by the Mayor and Borough Council of the BOROUGH; and

WHEREAS, the necessary resolutions have been adopted prior to the execution of this agreement:

WITNESSETH, that the Borough hereby agrees as follows:

- A. To perform street sweeping as directed by the MTA BOROUGH for roads located with the MTA BOROUGH and will furnish a street sweeper and one operator to perform same.
- 1. The rates noted below will apply when BOROUGH employees and equipment are utilized in the street sweeping operations. The MTA BOROUGH agrees to reimburse the BOROUGH at the following rate:

- a. Street Sweeper with Operator \$95.00 per hour 2012 \$100.00 per hour 2013
- 2. Payment shall be made monthly upon receipt from the BOROUGH of a properly executed MTA BOROUGH voucher.
- 3. Time charged for services will include travel time to and from the assigned task and vehicle cleaning as a result of the services rendered.
 - 4. The MTA BOROUGH will provide the following:
 - a. Suitable location for dumping street sweeping materials
 - b. Water supply for the street sweeper as needed
 - c. Additional labor as necessary for the catch basin cleaning

This Agreement shall be effective on the date of execution and shall be for the calendar year commencing as of the execution of this agreement through December 31, 2013. Thereafter, the contract shall be automatically renewable, unless terminated in accordance with the procedure set forth below.

The BOROUGH reserves the right to renegotiate this Agreement at any time during the life of the Agreement for the purpose of rate schedule modifications. If the parties are unable to reach a satisfactory agreement as to a renegotiated rate schedule, the BOROUGH reserves the right to terminate this Agreement upon fifteen (15) calendar days written notice to the MTA BOROUGH.

This Agreement will be extended on a year to year basis, unless notice is given by either the MTA BOROUGH or the BOROUGH of their desire to terminate or modify the Agreement upon fifteen (15) calendar days written notice and the MTA BOROUGH hereby agrees to pay for all services rendered to the date of termination and the BOROUGH hereby agrees not to terminate services until the expiration of the fifteen (15) calendar days written notice time period.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused these presents to be signed by their duly authorized proper officers and their proper seals affixed hereto all on the day and year first above written.
