There is a no tolerance policy in RVSL and there will be a fine, which Kim has asked to take on as policy says the coach of the team should receive. She will have a meeting to discuss the rules with the coaches and parents. Christina will also be making sure there is a no tolerance clause in the registration as an additional reminder that parents do not speak to the refs. Numbers for fall are currently 10 for Munchkin, E 7, D 6, C4
