A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REQUESTING APPROVAL OF ITEMS OF REVENUE AND APPROPRIATION NJS 40A:4-87 FOR ACQUISITION OF IN-VEHICLE AND BODY CAMERAS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT ADOPTED APRIL 6, 2021

WHEREAS, NJS 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and WHEREAS, the Director may also approve the insertion of an appropriation for the equal amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, in the county of Morris, New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2021 in the sum of \$61,140.00, which is now available as a revenue from NJ Department of Law and Public Safety, SFY21 Body Worn Camera Grant Program. Pursuant to the provision of the statute, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the like sum of \$61,140.00. is hereby appropriated under the caption NJ Department of Law and Public Safety, SFY21 Body Worn Camera Grant Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$105,000 representing the amount required for the municipality's share of the aforementioned undertaking or improvement is provided within adopted Ordinance 04-2021 appropriating \$105,000.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the Acquisition of In-Vehicle and Body Cameras for the Police Department adopted April 6, 2021.
