ORDINANCE 01 - 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 207, TATTOO & BODY PIERCING ESTABLISHMENTS, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington (the "Borough"), County of Morris in the State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 207-5, "Medical certificate," of Chapter 207 in the Borough Code, Tattoo and Body Piercing Establishments, is to read as follows:

§ 207-5. Medical certificate.

Every person engaged in the practice of tattooing or body piercing shall submit proof to the Health Department that he or she has been vaccinated for hepatitis B and has had a PPD skin test for tuberculosis.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of any ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. If any article, section, subsection, clause, paragraph, phrase, sentence or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, said article, section, subsection, clause, paragraph, phrase, sentence or provision shall be deemed separable without effect on the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final publication as provided by law.
