**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH  
OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,  
AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A SFY21 BODY-WORN CAMERA GRANT  
FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY,  
OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, AWARD NUMBER 21-BWC-054**

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey, Department of Law & Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General (OAG) received funds from the SFY21 Budget to administer the Body-Worn Camera Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Body-Worn Camera Grant Program is designed to provide eligible law enforcement agencies with State funding to aid in the purchase of body-worn cameras, ancillary equipment and storage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Mount Arlington has been awarded a grant from the New Jersey Department of Law & Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General, U.S.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grant Program is SFY21 Body-Worn Camera Grant, award number 21-BWC-054, with an award period of January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, per Resolution 2021-111 the grant awarded from the State is \$61,140.00 and a local match as stipulated in Ordinance 04-2021 of \$105,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Mount Arlington is hereby authorized and does hereby accept the grant award for the purchase of body-worn cameras; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Governing Body of the Borough of Mount Arlington that it hereby accepts the grant award in the amount of \$61,140.00 for the purchase of body-worn cameras for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2025.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Mount Arlington that the Mayor, Administrator and Chief of Police are hereby authorized to execute the Award Contract with the State and take any further action necessary for the acceptance of the grant award.
