WHEREAS, the Borough of Mount Arlington has received funds pursuant to The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 in the amount of \$612,520.00 (the "ARP Funds"); and

WHEREAS, the Mount Arlington High Pressure Booster Station needs to be replaced and improved (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project is an eligible use of the ARP Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey hereby appropriate \$612,520.00 in ARP Funds for the purpose of replacing and improving the Mount Arlington High Pressure Booster Station.
