## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND ROAD CLOSURES DURING THE LAKE HOPATCONG ELKS 5K RUN/WALK
