

**BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON
REORGANIZATION MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 2, 2024
6:00 P.M.**

The Reorganization Meeting of the Borough of Mount Arlington was held on Tuesday, January 3, 2023. This meeting was held in-person at the Municipal Building at 419 Howard Boulevard, Mount Arlington, New Jersey.

Mayor Stanzilis called the meeting to order at 6:04PM.

Mr. Bansch, Borough Clerk, stated “adequate notice of this Reorganization Meeting of the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington was given as required by the Open Public Meetings Act as follows: Notice was published in the Daily Record and the Roxbury Register on December 14, 2023 and posted on the bulletin board in the main hallway of the Borough Municipal Building; notice of this meeting is on file in the Office of the Borough Clerk. In accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act (N.J.S.A. 10:4-1 et seq.), the Borough Council opens every public meeting for comments of the public. However, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 10:4-12: ‘Nothing in this Act shall be construed to limit the discretion of a public body to permit, prohibit or regulate the active participation at any meeting.’ Speakers at Borough meetings shall have five minutes to present their comments to the Borough Council so as not to consume time that would otherwise be allotted to other persons who wish to speak.”

Mayor Stanzilis led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance. He asked everyone to remain standing to observe a moment of silence to remember former Councilman and Council President Bob Sorge who passed away this year.

Mayor Stanzilis expressed his appreciation for Council President Delaney, who attended almost every Borough meeting, including committee meetings.

Mayor's Address

Mayor Stanzilis stated it was a great year. He reported on the many accomplishments of 2023.

- The majority of Borough water and sewer projects were either completed or in the planning stages.
 - McGregor Avenue Road Improvements and Watermain Extension project
 - Project awarded, with construction to begin January 2024.
 - Hover Drive and Floyd Drive Water and Sewer Main Extension Project
 - Water and sewer design completed. Construction bid in 2024.

- Windemere II
 - Water and sewer design completed. Construction bid in 2025. County road moratorium.
- Lake Rogerene Water Quality Management Plan and Wastewater Management Plan Amendment
 - Wastewater Management site-specific amendment to the Morris County Wastewater and Water Quality Management Plans to designate the Lake Rogerene community as part of the MSA sewer service area was submitted to NJDEP. Process to continue in 2024.
- General maintenance and Borough beautification
 - Updated street signs. The Borough has been receiving many compliments.
 - Regular schedule of street sweeping, which is critical to stormwater management.
 - Park Master Plan under development
 - Landscape architect John Thomas working with Borough Council on future plans for Borough's open space. A cohesive design plan for the parks that will also highlight their individual features.
 - Restore trail access between Memorial Park and the Municipal Beach property.
 - Improvements to Firemen's Field.
 - Continue planning and designing of trails where appropriate.
 - Landscaping returning "in house" with DPW taking over in 2024.
 - Potentially hire part time seasonal assistance, as we currently do for winter season, but no longer having a service outsourced in a multi-year contract.
 - Flowers and plantings throughout town
 - Rain gardens planned for five properties: Borough Hall; Police Department; Library; and both schools.
- Over \$700,000 in grants awarded or pending
 - Grants awarded
 - New Dial-a-Ride bus
 - Rain gardens - \$36,100
 - Replace some playground equipment at Firemen's Field and install lighting for the walking path - \$74,000
 - Stormwater Regulation requirements. State-mandated updates to Borough stormwater ordinances, processes and permit. Dave Clark and his team at CP Engineers have already commenced work. \$25,000
 - McGregor Trails Design - \$27,708
 - DOT Reba and Eric Road improvements - \$149,855
 - Water protection and planning design - \$15,000
 - Grants pending review
 - Fire Department Turnout Gear - \$71,250
 - US Congressional Appropriation Security System for auto license plate readers. Thanks to Congressman Tom Kean. - \$276,000
- Community events expanding due to a collaboration of staff and volunteer participation
 - Clean Communities Day
 - Lake-Wide Community Cleanup during Lake Hopatcong's 5-year drawdown
 - State Park Block Party
 - Memorial Day Parade

- 100th Anniversary Fire Department Parade
 - Special thanks to Jonathan Feinberg and the entire Fire Department for all their hard work.
- Summer Concert Series
 - Special thanks to Mark Rinaldi for his efforts.
- Halloween Bash
 - Special thanks to the Recreation Commission, Ms. Rinaldi and Ms. Todd for their hard work.

- Public safety
 - Fire Department Equipment Study underway
 - Master Plan of Department Vehicles, Borough needs and replacement schedule to ensure we are prudent stewards of taxpayer dollars.
 - Borough Public Safety Complex study underway to address the growing needs of the Fire Department and provide a more adequate Civic Center space. This is a long time in the making because the Borough has outgrown both facilities.
- Technology
 - Software Upgrade Roadway Management System
 - Will be utilized for Capital Planning. Provides length/width of all roads, current conditions and work history. Allows for planning levels of improvements needed for future years and how to budget.
 - TextMyGov
 - Launched on the borough website, TextMyGov is another convenient way to communicate with the Borough. This smart texting solution works with regular SMS texting, so no app or download is needed. TextMyGov uses a mobile phone's regular messaging service as a simple way for the town to interact with the public and for citizens to relay information to town staff. For example, easily report code violation, public works issues like potholes, road damages and more. The Borough is able to engage citizens, start a workflow, and ask specific guided questions regarding location, address, street name, and more.
 - Spatial Data Logic (SDL)
 - Widely used within other municipalities, Mount Arlington will implement in 2024. The State is now requiring an electronic option for construction permit applications. Sharing service with Jefferson Township for Construction Officials already creates a cost savings. As a result of the shared service with Jefferson, the Borough is able to work with Jefferson to implement SDL in Mount Arlington at a significantly reduced rate.
 - Remote work ability
 - The Borough now has the ability to access all systems remotely to provide the level of service and response our residents have come to expect.
- Shared Services - cost savings but continued level of service
 - Shared Court with Wharton Borough
 - Construction Official agreement with Jefferson Township

- Health Department shared service agreement with Mount Olive Township
- Animal Control shared service agreement with Hopatcong Borough as the lead agency; Wharton Borough; Byram Township; Stanhope Borough as well as Netcong Borough joining
- Saint Clare's Ambulance Service
- Morris County Joint Insurance Fund (JIF) with 45 other municipalities. Ms. Rinaldi just completed 2-year term of Chairwoman; continues to serve on executive committee.
- Wharton DPW Supervisor and Licensed Water/Sewer Operator. Important to note shared service is for supervisory staff. The Borough has its own 6 full-time DPW employees.
- Various co-ops for purchasing needs.

Mayor Stanzilis thanked the Police Department, Fire Department, Borough Staff and Borough Professionals for making everything possible. He thanked Ms. Rinaldi for her outstanding leadership. He thanked the Borough Council who were a truly committed group. He thanked his wife, Laura, for her unending support and patience.
