**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF

DESIGNATING MEETING DATES FOR THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON
BOARD OF HEALTH FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-18 of the Open Public Meetings Act provides that within seven days of the Annual Reorganization Meeting of the Board of Health of the Borough of Mount Arlington, or if there be no such organization meeting, than no later than January 10th, every public body shall establish by Resolution a Schedule of Regular Meetings of the Board of Health to be held during the succeeding year and shall post and maintain posted throughout the year and mailed to the designated newspapers and submitted to persons requesting same, in writing, copies of such schedule of regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, said Schedule shall contain the location of each meeting to the extent it is known and the time and date of each meeting; and


