- Council President Delaney
 - Council President Delaney provided a recap of the Mount Arlington Semiquincentennial event on July 11, 2026.
- Councilwoman Fostle
 - Councilwoman Fostle encouraged residents to participate in guided kayaking, with August's event being a sunset kayaking.
 - Councilwoman Fostle provided a recap of Mount Arlington's America's 250th Celebration on July 11th.
 - Councilwoman Fostle announced Fall Sports registration has begun and will end on August 16th.
 - Councilwoman Fostle encouraged residents with businesses to become a vendor at the Halloween Bash this year.
 - The next Summer Concert will be held at the Municipal Beach on August 27th from 6-8pm.
- Councilwoman Galate
 - Councilwoman Galate thanked the Borough employees for participating in the 250th event. The DPW for their work with set up and break down, and the Police and Fire for having booths.
 - Councilwoman Galate announced that the Library has new books for the public to use.
 - Councilwoman Galate encouraged residents to visit the Borough website for the latest Board of Health information.

 - Councilman Fuller thanked the Borough staff and Semiquincentennial Committee for their work on the 250th celebration.
 - Councilman Fuller also thanked the CERT members who volunteered to assist with parking logistics for the event.
 - CERT held a meeting on July 22nd and has two new applicants.

- At the CERT meeting, Dr. Tony Spina gave an overview of the latest storms, and CERT's response.
- CERT members Darlene Kadel and Eileen German completed their HAM operator training and can join RACES.
- CERT members are also completing courses in CPR and AED usage.
- Councilman Fuller announced the Police's program "Neighbors Helping Neighbors" and encouraged residents to volunteer.

Borough Administrator's Report- None

Police Department Report-

- Chief Sherburne stated Ptl. Kaiteris conducted Active Shooter Training for approximately half of the department at Mount Arlington Public School utilizing live simulation rounds. Training equipment was provided by the Morris County Sheriff's Emergency Response Team (SERT).
- Ptl. Kaiteris attended "Shoot House" training in Morris Plains with Morris County SERT.
- Sgt. Farina and Ptl. Pizzuta assisted the Hackettstown Police Department with security for a FIFA World Cup Celebration and Food Truck Festival.
- Members of the department participated in the Mount Arlington 250th event at Memorial Park.
- The department is expected to launch the Neighbor to Neighbor Program in August. The program is focused on residents meeting with each other to assist those who may not have a support system. Those interested in participating should contact the department.
- The police have been enforcing the new E-Bike law, and have noticed a drastic decline of E-Bikes on the road.

Fire Department Report-

- Chief Marciano stated most of the calls for July were due to the storms over the holiday weekend.
- Chief Marciano stated that the department has been provided the opportunity to use the old Lady of the Lake school for training, and have invited mutual aid departments to join in the training.
- The department keeps growing with new additions, and members going through the academy.

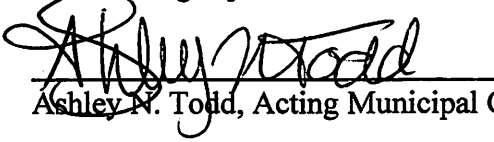
