

RESOLUTION 2024 – 72

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING A FEE SCHEDULE AND CAPACITY LIMIT FOR ACCESS TO THE MUNICIPAL BEACH

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mount Arlington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Beach is open to residents of the State of New Jersey, and reasonable access shall be afforded for residential and non-residential use of the Municipal Beach; however, capacity limits may be set by Resolution of the Governing Body to ensure public safety.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 06-2020, adopted by the Borough Council on October 6, 2020, reasonable fees may be charged any person seeking access to the Municipal Beach and recreational facilities from Memorial Day through Labor Day, so as to provide funds to improve, maintain and police the Municipal Beach and to provide facilities and safeguards for recreation, including the employment of lifeguards and other necessary personnel; and

WHEREAS, such fees must be set by Resolution of the Borough Council, in accordance with applicable law, and must also take into consideration those amounts already paid by any person paying ad valorem taxes to the Borough to provide funds for the above referenced purposes; and

WHEREAS, capacity limits may be set by Resolution of the Borough Council to ensure public safety; and


WHEREAS, the Borough desires to set the following fee and capacity schedule for the 2024 Municipal Beach season:

| Non-Resident Daily Beach Badge | \$10.00 per day Monday through Friday \$20.00 per day Saturday and Sunday (per car and includes Placard) |
| Resident Daily Beach Badge | Required |
| Non- Resident Parking Placard | Required |
| Resident Parking Placard | Required |
| Beach Capacity Limit | Ninety (90) people, up to thirty (30) non-residents |
| Parking Lot Capacity | Twenty-three (23) spaces, up to ten (10) non-resident cars |

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and the Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Borough hereby authorizes the fees and capacity limits set forth herein.
3. If any part of this Resolution shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereby shall not affect the remaining parts of this Resolution.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Borough Clerk.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately, as provided by law.
