

RESOLUTION #2026- 114

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT ARLINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING A MORRIS COUNTY TRAIL GRANT APPLICATION AMENDING A REPLACING RESOLUTION 2026-90

WHEREAS, the Morris County Board of Chosen Freeholders authorized the creation of the Trail Construction Grant Program (hereinafter "Program) to provide funding to any of its 39 municipalities for recreational trail construction projects; and

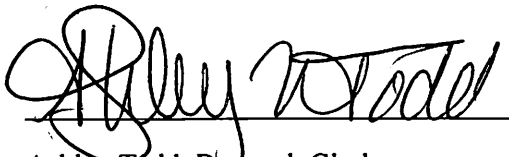
WHEREAS, the Program is funded through the Morris County Open Space, Recreation, Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund and requires a 20% match from applicants through a financial contribution of in-kind services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mount Arlington is submitting a grant to the Morris County Trail Construction Grant Program in the amount of \$258,308.07 with a 20% match by Mount Arlington of \$64,577.02 totaling \$322,885.09 for a project entitled Mount Arlington McGregor Trails. Signage and plantings are additional project items to be funded by the Borough and not reimbursable expenditures under the grant specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Governing Body of the Borough of Mount Arlington do hereby authorize the preparation and submission of a 2026 Morris County Trail Construction Grant Application; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Governing Body of the Borough of Mount Arlington acknowledge the grant program will operate on a reimbursement basis only and agree to provide full advance funding to complete the proposed project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt of the Grant Agreement, the Borough Council authorizes the Mayor to execute such agreement on behalf of the Borough of Mount Arlington and that this signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement. This Resolution shall take effect immediately. **I HEREBY CERTIFY** this to be a true and correct Resolution of the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Arlington, and adopted on September 1, 2026
